

Abstract

The purpose of this study is to determine the relationship between the adversity quotient and the professionalism of Madrasah Allyah teachers in remote areas of South Banawa Subdistrict, Donggala Regency, Central Sulawesi; and the relationship between the university quotient and the independence of learning Madrasah Allyah students in remote areas of South Banawa Subdistrict, Donggala Regency, Central Sulawesi. The participants in this study, Participants in this research include instructors, students, and administrative staff from Madrasah Allyah, which is located in a rural region of South Banawa Subdistrict, Donggala Regency, Central Sulawesi, as well as the general public.
